Charity Quiz Nights



We are pleased to announce that the Charity Quiz nights will restart on 22nd September 2020. The allocated cause is the Samuel Lee Charity.

As you would expect, given the current Corona Virus out-break, we have revised our risk assessment to include the quiz and propose the following changes to the way it will be conducted. We will review this after the first quiz and see how things went.

- The quiz will commence at 8:30 as usual. However, where possible, can you arrive early to ensure that there is not a rush at the entrance.
- There will be upto 15 teams allowed to take part. Teams should be from no more than two households and upto four people ideally but no more than six. There are limited spaces for teams of six.
- To take part you must book a table by email to info@thegeddingtonstar.co.uk. In the mail confirm your party size and approximate proposed arrival time. We will reply with your table allocation and acceptance of your arrival time.
- Drinks can be purchased at the table only, there is no service at the bar. Order sheets will be placed on each table to allow you to book drinks for each interval between quiz rounds.
- Regrettably, there will be no raffle until the situation improves as this involves multiple contact points. Instead we will have two draws through the night, each will select a winning table. The table winning will receive a round of drinks or a voucher for a round of drinks.
- As you know the entry fee and the raffle are donated to the chosen charity. To keep revenue for the charity up, while there is no raffle, we are doubling the entry fee to £2 per person. Please bring this in exact cash on the day.
- Bring your own pen. At the end of the quiz please take your answer sheets with you or dispose of them in the waste bin provided.
- Otherwise the format of the quiz will be much the same and we will do all we can to ensure that it is as dull and disappointing as usual.
